



Exemption for Required School Immunization(s)

The Summit County Health Department (SCHD) strongly supports immunization as one of the easiest and most effective tools in preventing serious communicable diseases. These diseases can cause serious illness and even death. The Summit County Health Department believes the benefits of immunization outweigh the risk of adverse events which may be associated with the vaccines. *We also recognize that parents/legal guardians have the right to make the decision, should they choose not to immunize their child.*

Obtaining an Immunization Exemption at the Summit County Health Department

1. Exemptions are obtained at one of the Summit County Health Department offices located in Coalville, Kamas, and Park City. Please see address and telephone information at the bottom of this page.
2. The charge is \$20 per exemption.
3. One exemption, obtained at a child's entrance to a Summit County School District, usually covers the child for their entire schooling within the district. The parent is strongly encouraged to keep their copy of the signed exemption should a school request a replacement copy. Each time an exemption is requested at the SCHD there will be a \$20 charge. When a child moves to another school district, a new exemption may be required by the new school district.
4. Exemptions should be obtained in the district where the child lives.
