




About Park City High School

Park City High School is nestled in the mountains of the year-round resort town of Park City, Utah. With an enrollment of 1,212 students, the school has a 94 percent graduation rate placing it in the top 1 percent in the nation. Park City High offers a full education program with a strong core curriculum of liberal arts and science. Our students also experience a comprehensive college and career preparation. The Miners are known for an outstanding extracurricular and athletic program. Students participate in award-winning clubs, vibrant fine arts programs and one of the top high school athletic programs in the state.



- A 94% graduation rate — more than 10% higher than the state average, and in the top 1 percent of the nation.
- In the U.S. News & World Report's 2017 rankings, Park City High School is one of only three high schools in Utah to earn a gold medal.
- The Washington Post also ranked Park City High the No. 1 high school in the State of Utah in 2017.
- A top Advanced Placement district in Utah with a 75% student participation rate and a 70% pass rate.



- PCHS has 83 licensed staff members, 35 support staff, and 3 administrators.
- Our average class size is 28:1.
- Park City Center for Advanced Professional Studies (PCCAPS) offers courses in digital design, business strategy, engineering, software development, and teacher



education. Instructors develop real-world, project-based learning strategies through collaboration with business and community partners.

- The Marching Band will represent the United States at the 75th anniversary of D-Day June 6, 2019, in Normandy, France.

- As an active partner in the annual Sundance Film Festival held each January, our high school students participate in Filmmakers in the Classroom program. Additionally, Sundance offers students the opportunity to celebrate the art of cinematic storytelling. Students view short films, and have opportunities to interact with both emerging and established filmmakers from around the globe.



- Annually participate in TEDx Youth in cooperation with the Park City Institute.

- PCSD was named an Apple Distinguished Program for 2014-16 for implementation of its "one-to-one" initiative that supplies students (grades 2-12) with laptops to use in the classroom and to take home.

- The nearby Park City Learning Academy provides Park City High School students with an alternative setting for core class instruction. Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors enroll in their Math, Science, Social Studies and English Language Arts courses. The PCLA provides students with personal attention and quality instruction via small class sizes. An after-school program offers credit recovery.
