Dear Parents:

As we approach the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year, we want to take the opportunity to thank you all for your participation in this program, and for helping us make 2017-2018 a successful year. In August of 2016, we combined our Park City School District Community Education After School Program with Holy Cross Ministries' After School Program. The past two years have been full of learning, growth, making new friends, and embracing incredible opportunities.

Due to the success of this collaboration, we want to make you aware of a program change for the upcoming school year. As of Fall 2018, the administration of the After School Program Camps will be handled solely by the Park City School District. When Holy Cross Ministries first began offering out of school time programming for families who could not afford it, there was no other option for these students. As a non-profit with a long history in this community, it has been an honor to support the Park City School District over the past few years as they developed the capacity to expand their program offerings. Holy Cross Ministries will continue to provide outreach support as an After School Program partner in this new chapter. Holy Cross Ministries will also continue to co-administer the Summer Camp Program in partnership with The Park City School District.

The After School Program Camps will continue at each of the elementary schools in the 2018-2019 school year and scholarships will continue to be available to families on an as needed basis. Under the supervision of the PCSD Community Education Department, The Park City School District will continue to develop the four main pillars of this program: academic enrichment, homework help, physical education, and field trips. It is our main priority to keep the children safe in a positive and engaging learning environment and ensure that no family is turned away due to cost. This is a great service for working parents and students will continue to build their STEM and literacy skills with a host of new, fun projects and learning opportunities next year. We will continue our partnerships with some of Park City's most amazing organizations: EATS Park City, Kids Outdoors, Basin Recreation, the MARC, Youth Sports Alliance, Latinos in Action, and Big Brothers Big Sisters. In this new phase of our collaboration, Holy Cross Ministries will continue to support the program as a partner.

We are extremely proud of all the community partnerships that make this program possible. With the ongoing help of Park City Education Foundation, United Way, and Park City Community Foundation, The Park City School District will be able to continue to provide the highest quality of after school programming in town, with a unique fusion of fun and academic enrichment. This year we will focus on monitoring the success of our program and ensuring that we are providing the strongest academic support that we can. We will target the areas where students need help the most, and focus on building the essential skills they need to succeed in regular day school.
