## Community Priorities

The community's five most important master planning priorities include:

1. **Timeline:** move 9th grade to high school as soon as possible
2. **Educational Programming:** expand capacity to house current programs
3. **Flexible vs. Traditional:** Modify existing facilities that are adaptable for the future
4. **School Location:** Maintain current locations
5. **Cost vs. Goals:** Minimize costs

## Critical Questions

- + DOES PCSD WANT TO OFFER UNIVERSAL PRE-K AND HOW SHOULD THIS BE APPROACHED?
- + IS THERE A PREFERRED ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL OPTION AND CAN ANY ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE SCHOOL OPTIONS BE ELIMINATED?
- + HOW EXTENSIVE SHOULD THE HIGH SCHOOL REMODEL BE AND HOW SHOULD THE 9<sup>TH</sup> GRADE BE INTEGRATED?

## Next Steps

Currently, three internal task force groups are meeting:

- 1) Early Childhood Learning,
- 2) Secondary School Design, and
- 3) Equity, Access, and Opportunity.

The groups will provide master planning recommendations to the Board of Education in December.
