Dear Park City School District Parents/Guardians,

In support of Governor Herbert's announcement on March 13 and to continue our support of our staff and community, Park City School District is moving from "School Dismissal" to "School Telecommute" effective Thursday, March 19, at 2:30 p.m. We will continue to offer students with Grab & Go breakfast and lunch bags at Ecker Hill Middle or Treasure Mountain Junior High from 7:30 – 11:00 a.m. each weekday.

On Sunday, March 15, Summit County Health Officer Dr. Rich Bullough and Summit County Attorney Margaret Olson issued a countywide Public Health Order closing all resorts, restaurants, taverns, bars, entertainment venues, fitness and exercise facilities, spas, churches, and other businesses where people gather.

We want to do our part to prevent the COVID-19 virus from spreading through our community. Even though students will not be in our schools for the next week, we also have a responsibility to our staff and their well-being. We cannot educate our students if our staff are not healthy and safe. Our educators and support staff are our greatest resource, and we know their preparation from home through telecommuting will keep our students learning and growing.

Our educators and staff will be working remotely throughout the closure. Schools will be closed for the protection of our administrators and teachers in hopes of slowing the spread of COVID-19.
